COURSE OBJECTIVE

Students will learn both English and Italian lyric diction through the course structure: Preparation,

Practice and Performance. The purpose of this course is to teach singers pronunciation in both English and Italian as it applies to choral, art song, recital and opera repertoire.

In the **Preparation** stage, students will learn the International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA), how to apply it to the Italian and English language as well as aspects of style unique to each language.

In the **Practice** stage, students will apply their knowledge of IPA.

In the **Performance** stage, students will demonstrate their knowledge in written form and in class performance. Students will understand how diction can be an expressive tool while learning how to accurately transcribe both Italian and English IPA, how to accurately pronounce the symbols and gain confidence in both transcription and pronunciation.
