Course Description

A study of current topics in quality assurance management to include total quality control, statistical quality control, statistical process control, quality circles, and Deming's methods. Emphasis will be placed on the systems approach to quality assurance. Prerequisites: MGMT 3310 and BAN 3363. Credit 3. (SHSU Undergraduate Catalog).

Students are expected to read the text, take notes, participate in classroom activities and discussions, and complete all course requirements.

Course Objectives

 Students should gain factual knowledge (terminology, classification, methods, & trends for example).

• Students should learn the fundamental principles of the various quantitative methods used in quality management.

 Students should learn to apply the course material for problem solving and decision making.
