Current Projects:

Primary Care Provider Coverage in Texas –

I perform an annual analysis of federally & state funded patient encounters within all Texas counties. The focus is on the medically underserved &/or regions with reduced medical resources. Current & projected Texas Department of Health and Human Services (TDH) statistics are retrieved. The goal is to predict the need for Primary Care Providers (Physicians, Physician Assistants & Advanced Practice Nurses) in those regions of Texas with the most need for health care accessibility.

Electrocardiogram (EKG) ‘Kwik-Look’ Application –

I have developed a Smart Phone Application that provides students (or professionals) with a simple, step-by-step, program for interpreting an Electrocardiogram. User templates have been structured. Smart Phone application programming is extremely costly and I am currently exploring Grant resources to fund the project

Mercy Trips African Outreach –

I travel annually to Uganda, Africa with a non-profit organization known as Mercy Trips (mercytrips.org). Working with a regional hospital, the group sets up clinics in remote settlements in rural Uganda. Free medical care is provided to villagers who have no access to any health care facilities. Mercy Trips travels twice a year, in January and July. I most often travel on just one trip per year.

Diabetes and Ghrelin

This is a project in collaboration with Dr. Daryl Stinson, a McAllen physician. The investigation explores the significance of controlling ghrelin secretion as a means to manage Type II Diabetes. Regulation of ghrelin has demonstrated substantial reduction in body mass index, Hemoglobin A1c and associated co-morbidities. Ghrelin is a hormone, secreted in the stomach. It is the ‘Hunger Enzyme’, associated with increased appetite and stimulation of Growth Hormone.
