Tuition & Fees


Tuition rates are based on residency for undergraduate and graduate programs. You are eligible for resident rates if you currently live in Texas and have so for the last twelve months.

Tuition rates may be revised by the Legislature at any time. All tuition and fees are correct as of date of print but are subject to change by action of the State Legislature or by the Board of Regents of The Texas State University System. Out-of-state tuition is calculated each year by the Coordinating Board.
