Submit Your Transcript

Ask your high school to send an official high school transcript with GPA, date of (expected) graduation, and graduation plan to Sam Houston State University. (Code: 003606)

Optional Submit Your Test Scores

If you choose to send your test scores, contact the appropriate testing agency to request submission to SHSU. (SAT school code 6643; ACT school code 4162)

Requirements

Eligible applicants should graduate high school with one of the following diploma types: Foundations with Endorsement(s)* or Distinguished Level of Achievement.
