#### Coursework

The Master of Science in Criminal Justice is a 36-hour degree program. No thesis is required for this degree; instead, students complete a capstone course, which addresses the effect of emergent perspectives in organization theory on public administration, criminal justice management and leadership, as well as the impact of emergent technology upon criminal justice operations. You must complete the capstone course with a grade of B or better to satisfy the university's comprehensive examination requirement.

# **Scholarships & Financial Aid**

Approximately 60% of our student body receive financial assistance through, federal, state, and local programs administered by the Student Financial Aid Office. Grants, loans, and scholarships are available to qualified students. To apply for financial aid at SHSU, students must submit the most current "Free Application for Federal Student Aid" (FAFSA.ed.gov). The Title IV code for SHSU is 003606.

Veterans are eligible for benefits under the Hazelwood Act if they were residents of Texas at the time they entered the armed forces, are now residents, and were honorably discharged. Students eligible for this benefit should contact the Registrar's Office prior to enrolling in classes.

# MS IN CHEMISTRY

The Master of Science in Chemistry degree program at Sam Houston State University gives students a quality education in the fundamental and applied knowledge of chemistry, including how to critically examine and analyze observations and how to use chemical understanding to propose solutions to problems that may arise in industry, academia, or various other careers associated with chemistry.

Students will have the opportunity for hands-on experience working with atomic absorption, gas chromatography, high performance liquid chromatography, ultraviolet and visible spectroscopy, nuclear magnetic resonance spectroscopy, inductively-coupled plasma atomic emission spectrometry, mass spectrometry, ion chromatography, capillary electrophoresis, x-ray crystallography, and other standard instrumentation in the field.

# FUNDING YOUR FUTURE

Students in the Chemistry graduate program receive financial support from a variety of sources including:

- → All students are normally supported on a graduate assistantship.
   (a 3.0 GPA is required for support; approximately \$19,000/year for 2024-25)
- → International and out-of-state students with assistantships may receive tuition waivers, allowing them to pay significantly reduced in-state tuition rates.
- → Recent students have received summer support through a grant from the Robert A. Welch Foundation and other sources. (normally \$2,250 each summer)
- → Students are eligible to apply for competitive scholarships from the Graduate and Professional School and from the College of Science and Engineering Technology.

# ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

# Complete the online application at shsu.edu/apply

→ Pay the \$50 non-refundable application fee.

# Submit official transcripts

→ Provide official transcripts of all previous college work, official GRE scores (optional), CV/resume and personal statement (optional), three letters of recommendation and TOEFL scores (if appropriate).

# An acceptable undergraduate GPA

→ Must have a major or minor in chemistry with at least a 2.5 GPA in undergraduate chemistry courses.
