

May 29, 2024 I received the program termination appeal you submitted to me on May 20, 2024. As part of my review, I read the appeal you submitted to me and I obtained information from included information about prior correspondence with you about this matter. In addition, I reviewed the relevant SHSU Academic Policy Statement 910312. The policy in reference can found here. I understand you faced challenging circumstances during the semesters in which you have been enrolled in the program. In December of 2023, you were notified of your academic standing and advised of the requirements to remain in the program. In Spring 2024, you chose to and upon completion of the semester your cumulative GPA remained below 3.00. I do not find evidence to overturn decision to follow SHSU policy in this situation. I understand this is not the response you wanted to receive. Please review Policy 910312 Section 10.02 to understand the next steps if you wish to continue with your appeal. SHSU Academic Policy Statement 910312 indicates the following: "The student may appeal the decision of the chair in writing to the appropriate academic

dean within ten (10) working days following the chair's decision."

This means you can appeal to the Dean of the College of Criminal Justice, Please let me know of any questions you have about the appeal procedures. I can be reached at


