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Container Storage Areas

1. Accumulation Time (labels)

2. Hazardous Waste / Waste Containers

Satellite Accumulation Areas

Exceedance of 55 gallons of hazardous waste or 1 quart of acutely hazardous waste:

Universal Wastes (UW)

Batteries, pesticides, mercury-containing equipment, lamps, and paint and paint related waste

Labeling of UW Containers

Containers managing UW **must** be clearly marked as follows:
