My research area of focus is victimization, both in person and online. I have just finished a long-term qualitative project in which I conducted in-person interviews with survivors of sexual assault and intimate partner violence from 2013-2020 (both heterosexual and LGBTQIA+ individuals) and their family members and friends throughout the state of Illinois. Both the family and survivors also experienced cybervictimizations (cyberstalking, cyberharassment, revenge porn, sextortion, social engineering, cyber fraud and/or identity theft) in addition to the in person victimization. I am in the process of writing up the results from this study into manuscripts for publications. I have been honored to speak about this research at the U.N Women in 2016 and a Congressional Briefing in 2018 in support of the passage of the ENOUGH Act.
