Performance Objective Description:

Results Description:

In the academic year 2021-2022, 8 new students were accepted to program. This was a success rate of 80% of the goal.

Action Description:

We added 8 students to the program, which was positive growth. However, we will continue to work with the COE recruitment staff to to recruit new students. Additionally, we will continue conversations with the Grad Hub staff to consider moving all courses to an online format. Distance Learning funds are available if the classes are offered online, however, International students and military students require face-to-face courses. This presents an opportunity for further investigation.

100% (n=18) of students passed the culminating projects in CIED 5341 and 5340.

Indicator Description:

Students will complete an action research project in CIED 5370 and 5085 designed to allow students to identify educational issues, address the issue through research, report on findings, and make recommendations.

Criterion Description:

100% of students will successfully complete their action research projects and receive a passing score.

Findings Description:

9 of 10 (90%) students successfully passed the action research project.

Action - Educational Leadership

Action Description:

Because we did not reach the goal of 100% of students successfully passing the research project, we will create a mechanism for identification of students who may be in need of extra support on this project. Only one of the 10 students was not successful, so we believe this is an outlier.
