There were 12 candidates enrolled in the program. Of these 12 candidates, 12 earned a B or better in all coursework.

Evidence of Mastery of Course Objectives

Action Description:

The program faculty are creating a survey for program completers to identify strengths and weaknesses of the program. The graduate program coordinator will complete this during the candidates' last semester.

We will increase recruitment by 10% annually and retain all enrolled candidates.

1 candidate completed the program. This is a 20% retention rate.
