100% of candidates will successfully pass the TExES #292 content exam.

Findings Description:

All graduating students completed the EC-3 TExES exam prior to being admitted to their final semester of course and field work.

Action Description:

All students in the PK-3 degree program completed the EC-3 TExES exam successfully to be recommended for Texas Teacher Certification.

PPR Certification Exam

Learning Objective Description:

100% of candidates will pass the Pedagogy and Professional Responsibility and state exam.

PPR: Indicator, Criterion, and Findings Item

Indicator Description:

Indicator type: Exam. The PPR exam is a state-mandated exam required of all teacher candidates to obtain state teaching certification. It measures candidates knowledge and understanding of the professional responsibilities of a teacher and the appropriate pedagogy for PK-3 teaching.

Criterion Description:

100% of candidates will successfully pass the PPR exam.

Findings Description:

Graduating students completed the PPR TExES successfully and were recommended for certification in the last semester of their coursework.

Action Description:

All students in the PK-3 degree program completed the PPR TExES exam successfully to be recommended for Texas Teacher Certification.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 1

Science of Teaching Reading Exam

Learning Objective Description:

100% of candidates will successfully pass the state Science of Teaching Reading (STR) exam.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 2

STR: Indicator, Criterion, and Findings Item

Indicator Description:

Indicator type: Exam. The Science of Teaching Reading exam is a state-mandated assessment of candidates' understanding of the basic concepts of reading acquisition and instruction. All candidates are required by the state to pass the exam in order to obtain certification.

Criterion Description:

100% of candidates will successfully pass the STR exam.

Findings Description:

All students successfully completed the STR TExES exam prior to their final semester or YLR semester 2. If the students were not successful they were required to take a semester without field experience blocked courses to provide time to study and pass the STR TExES exam. Monitoring of student progress, degree counseling, and workshops assisted students toward success
