COUN 5399:

- 1. competency is measured by instructor observation of 2 practice sessions using the play therapy skills checklist
- 2. student must receive a score of pass on both observations

- 1. acquisition of knowledge is measured by passing score on students final case presentation
- 2. student must demonstrate ability to provide accurate diagnosis and create a treatment plan for one adolescent or child client

COUN 5398:

1. competency is measured by instructor observation of one sandtray demonstration of which the student is the lead facilitator

COUN 6331:

- 1. acquisition of skill is measured by instructor observation of at least one practice session of group play therapy and at least one practice session of expressive art activity
- 2. student must receive a score of pass on both observations

Criterion Description:

Students enrolled in Play Therapy coursework will earn a grade of B or better in each course.

Findings Description:

COUN 5398

In summer of 2023, 12 students were enrolled in 5398. All 12 students scored in the competent or proficient range on the Sandtray observation.

COUN 6331

Data could not be collected for for spring 2023 semester. blackboard would not access the data.

COUN 5399

In fall of 2022, 23 students were enrolled in 5399. All 23 students scored in the competent or proficient range on the play therapy skills observation.

COUN 5391

In Sumemer of 2023, 22 students were enrolled in 5391.01. All 22 students scored in the competent or profiecient range on the treatment plan assignment.

In summer of 2023, 20 students were enrolled in 5391.02. All 20 students scored in the competent or proficient range on the treatment plan assignment.
