Update of Progress to the Previous Cycle's PCI:

Enrollment for the Critical Infrastructure certificate program has been monitored. Because the certificate is comprised of approximately half of the coursework required for the MS in Security Studies, most students declare the certificate in their final term, making enrollment tracking challenging.

Successful completion of assignments from required coursework has been identified as a direct method of assessment in place of prior IDEA survey scores.

Enrollment will continued to be monitored in the Critical Infrastructure certificate program, with an emphasis on identifying certificate students prior to their final term.
