Criterion Description:

At least 80% of students will earn an average rating of 4/5 on each section of the rubric.

Findings Description:

100% of students earned an average rating of at least a 4/5 on each section of the rubric.

Action Description:

100% of students enrolled in 5370/5371 this term created a research project to implement/apply acquired skills in research.
