Students will have two opportunities to demonstrate their knowledge of couple and family counseling. The first opportunity is foundational knowledge of theories. The second opportunity is the application of the theories to case studies.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 1

LO1: Students in the MCFC certificate will be knowledgeable in couple and family counseling theories. Learning Objective Description:

Students will complete a 50 question multiple choice/true false exam consisting of theories in couple and family counseling. The individual results will be available to students, and aggregated results will be available to program.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 2

ICF 1: KPI: Final exam in 6332 regarding couple and family theories.

Indicator Description:

Students will demonstrate knowledge of LO 1 with submission of Final Exam in COUN 6332. This key assessment will be graded automatically, and results will be available to the individual student, with aggregated data available to the program for overall student progress.

Criterion Description:

Criterion 1: 90% of students will receive 80% or above on the final exam.

Findings Description:

There is no spring data due to this assessment not being finalized in time. In summer 2024, 25 students took the 6332 final exam. 24/25 students scored over 80%. That is 96% of the class.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 3

Action: Final exam in 6332 regarding couple and family theories.

Action Description:

The final exam was not completed in the Qualtrics platform that was tied to TK20. Therefore, no results are in TK20, but remain in Blackboard. If adjunct professors teach 6332, there needs to be more reminders of where students should complete the final exam.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 1

LO2: Students in the MCFC certificate will be able to apply couple and family theories and techniques to a pre-selected case study.

Learning Objective Description:

Students will be presented with a case study and will apply knowledge of theories learned to the case study.
