

Seven Tips for Your Graduate Application



1. Admission Requirements

Visit the Degree Programs page and locate your intended program of study. Make note of the deadlines and admission requirements for your program.

2. Apply Texas Application

Plan to submit your application via Apply Texas at least three months before the deadline for your program. The application fee is non-refundable.

3. Transcripts

Transcripts showing your bachelor's degree conferral are required and are critical for a complete application. Allow for a minimum of two weeks for these to be received and added to your file. Additional transcripts where other coursework may be requested by some programs.



4. Standardized Tests

If your program requires the <u>GRE</u> or <u>GMAT</u> for admission, visit the testing service web site for more information and to register. Test scores are electronically submitted directly from the testing service and paired with your Apply Texas application when received. The institution code for the GRE is 6643. The <u>SHSU</u> <u>Testing Center</u> administers the GMAT.



5. References

If your program requires references, contact your referrers and let them know that you will be applying to graduate school at Sam Houston State University. Gather their contact information and provide yours.



6. Check Your Email

The email address you provide on your Apply Texas application will be used as the primary means of communication about your

application. Be sure to check it for important messages from SHSU.



7. Where to Send Supplemental Materials

After you submit your application, provide any supplemental materials. You can upload many items on your Bearkatlink.shsu.edu account, or mail or fax items to the Office of Graduate Admissions, SHSU, Box 2478, Huntsville, TX 77341-2478. Remember to provide your complete contact information on all items that you submit.
