FINANCIAL AID PROCESS

STEP 1

LEARN ABOUT SHSU

Find out more about SHSU by visiting our campus or going to shsu.edu/admissions.

STEP 2

SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA INFORMATION*

Visit **fafsa.gov** and use SHSU code 003606.

STEP 3

JOIN SHSU

If you are offered admission to SHSU, notify us of your intent to attend.

STEP 4

ACCEPT AWARD

If you are awarded financial aid, review and accept your awards.

STEP 5

VISIT STUDENT LOANS

If you accept a Direct Loan, you will need to visit studentloans.gov.

STEP 6

MAINTAIN GRADES

Maintain satisfactory academic progress throughout your career.

STEP 7

RENEW EACH YEAR

Apply each year to stay current.

* The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the basis for financial aid decisions at most universities. Loans, work-study, and scholarships are determined from the information, you supply on your application. To find the deadlines and other information, go to shsu.edu/finaid. Title IV code for SHSU is 003606.

FAFSA priority deadlines are November 1 (Fall and Spring) and September 30 (Spring only).

The Bearkat Promise guarantees all participating students enough grant and scholarship funds to cover the cost of mandatory* tuition and fees for 15 hours per semester!

*Bearkat Promise does not cover other non-mandatory fees.

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid can consist of grants, scholarships, loans, and work study. Most financial aid awards are based on financial need and eligibility. Scholarships can be based on merit and achievement.

- Grants do not need to be repaid.
- **Scholarships** are generally merit-based that do not need to be repaid.
- Loans have to be repaid with interest.
- Work Study provides wages for part-time employment.

Your financial aid package can be made up of any or all of these types of aid. There are more than 600 different types of scholarships for achievement in academic, leadership, honors, and extracurricular activities. SHSU uses a streamlined application, **Scholarships4Kats**, that automatically considers students for all relevant scholarships. Once accepted to SHSU, students will have access to our online scholarship portal.
