What is an Exchange Program?

- Pay tuition and fees to SHSU and a \$200 Study Abroad Service Fee
- Attend classes at one of our partner universities
- Take at least 12 credits at the partner university
- Receive transfer SHSU credit (SHSU grades awarded per course are "CR" (Credit) if passed or "NC" (No Credit) if not successfully completed)
- Pay housing & meals to the host university
- Financial Aid can apply & scholarships are available

- Fall: April 1
- Spring: November 1

• Summer: March 1
