

Steps to Studying Abroad

- 1. Attend Study Abroad Fair or Study Abroad 101 Information Session
- 2. Meet with the Study Abroad Coordinator (and faculty leader if a faculty-led program)
- Complete the Course Equivalency Form to ensure your courses abroad will transfer to SHSU (not for faculty-led programs)
- 4. Apply to your desired program
- 5. Submit all the necessary SHSU Study Abroad documents
- Apply for your visa, register for courses at your university abroad, apply for housing, and book your travel.
- Register in the US Department of State SMART Traveler Program Depart!

Deadlines for applying for a Study Abroad Program

Fall: April 1

Spring: November 1
 Summer: March 1

Helpful Links for All Study Abroad Students

- Interested in gaining intercultural competency before your program (or improving it
 afterwards)? Consider joining the <u>Global Ambassadors Program</u> which pairs domestic and
 international students for various organized activities throughout the semester.
- · Apply for a passport if you don't already have one.
 - Regardless of studying abroad, this is a very worthwhile document to have. It will save much stress if you already possess one well in advance of departure!
- Visas These are documents typically issued in your passport by a foreign government prior to
 departure from the US that authorize you to be in a given country over a specified period of
 time. Most countries have varied processes for obtaining a visa, but travelers are often
 required to appear in person at the nearest Consulate/Embassy of the destination country,
 and to submit various identification documents in order to apply. You cannot apply for a visa
 without first possessing a passport. Adequate planning on your part is required to comply
 with all immigration laws of the host country!
- Register in the <u>SMART Traveler program</u> through the U.S. State Department before departure, and check for any <u>travel</u> warnings to your destination country.
 - *SHSU will not approve any student travel to locations currently under US Dept. of State
 Travel Warning or locations that come under Travel Warning at any point in the study
 abroad process, including after the student has departed the US. Financial contingency
 plans should be made to compensate for any penalties incurred due to late program
 cancellation. Check the status of your proposed location below. No exceptions will be
 considered.

*PLEASE NOTE:

ALL study abroad students are charged a \$200 study abroad service fee that is NOT included in the program fees. It is a separate charge and is in addition to the program fee. This fee is only assessed after course registration and before departure.
