Description: Join us as we welcome SHSU President Emeritus James F. Gaertner to the Management Academy for the first time. Dr. Gaertner, SHSU's 12th University President (2001 - 2010), will discuss his perspective on the actions a leader must take to win his subordinates' loyalty, respect, and support. During his tenure as president of SHSU, the University added 14 new master's programs and two new doctoral

programs; achieved Carnegie Doctoral Research classification—which placed it in the top seven percent of all higher education institutions in the U.S.; presided over more than \$275 million of construction projects; and successfully completed its first capital campaign in history, raising more than \$60 million over five years. His successful career in both private industry and higher education have led him to formulate his observations on how effective leaders get to be that way.


