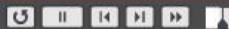

What is a University Police Department?



Commissioned police officers who assist with the security and safety of students, faculty, staff, and visitors on or around a college campus.



University Police vs. Campus Security



Police

- Has jurisdiction in any county the university leases, owns, or rents property.
- Able to take official police reports and investigate crimes.
- Able to arrest and serve warrants.

Security

- Only has jurisdiction on physical property.
- Reports referred to local police department.
- No arrest authority, but can detain.

You Can Help Prevent Property Crimes



Hide valuable items from plain sight

Ensure your vehicle and residence doors/windows are locked (even when you're home)

Record make, model, serial number, value, and description

Police can only record stolen property if serial number or owner applied number is noted.

Purchase parking permit from Parking/Trans. Office

Park between two white lines

Park in designated color lot

Register bicycles with Parking/Trans. office

Fire on Campus



Evacuate the building

Be responsible for your subordinates

Follow your department policies

Report any signs of smoke or fire to UPD or 911

SHSU EMERGENCY PROCEDURES QUICK REFERENCE

BOMB THREATS/SUSPICIOUS ITEMS:

- Pay close attention to the exact words the caller is using; document the call
- **Contact University Police at 936-294-1000 (4-1000 on campus)**
- **Do not** touch or handle suspicious items or packages
- Keep others away from area
- Notify your supervisor

DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR:

- **Contact University Police at 936-294-1000 (4-1000 on campus)**
- Give your name, location, what is happening and number of people involved (shooters/victims) if known
- If possible, exit the building or area immediately
- If exit is impossible, get to a room, lock or barricade the door, keep quiet, remain in place until all clear is given by law enforcement officials

FIRE: In case of fire or when the fire alarm sounds:

- Evacuate the building immediately using building emergency plan procedures
- **Do not** use the elevators
- Assist those with mobility problems
- **Contact University Police at 936-294-1000 (4-1000 on campus)**
- Report to supervisor at the designated site
- **Do not** re-enter the building until instructed by authorized personnel

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS:

- **Contact University Police at 936-294-1000 (4-1000 on campus)**
- Provide information on type and size of spill (if known)
- Evacuate the immediate area and building as directed
- Get decontamination instructions from authorities
- **Do not** re-enter area until all clear is given by authorized personnel

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:

- **Contact University Police at 936-294-1000 (4-1000 on campus)**
- Provide your name, location, number injured and description of injuries
- Stay on the phone for instructions on what to do

SEVERE WEATHER:

- Stay away from windows
- Take immediate shelter
- Monitor local radio and television stations
- **Follow all Signs** for University closings
- **Contact University Police at 936-294-1000 (4-1000 on campus)**
