Advanced Skills in Band Conducting

Goal Description:

MA in Band Conducting students should gain advanced skills in the areas of band rehearing, conducting, and teaching

RELATED ITEMS/ELEMENTS-----

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 1

Comprehensive Knowledge and Skills in Band Conducting and Pedagogy

Learning Objective Description:

MA in Band Conducting students should obtain a comprehensive knowledge of band literature, a basic knowledge of pedagogical practices for all major band instruments, and advanced skills in rehearsal conducting.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 2

Comprehensive Exam

Indicator Description:

Students will take a comprehensive exam in their final semester of study. The exam will be evaluated as Pass/Fail and will consist of the following:

- 1. A 14- to 25-minute preparation rehearsal with one of the ABC Directors' Bands. Composition selected by the ABC faculty. These rehearsals will be video-recorded and the candidate will meet with ABC faculty immediately after the session to review the video.
- 2. A start-up lesson with a beginner on CLARINET. (10 min.)
- 3. A start-up lesson with a beginner on HORN. (10 minutes)
- 4. A start-up lesson with a beginner on SNARE. (10 minutes)
- 5. A diagnostics rehearsal with an ABC master's candidate exit exam band in which players have been instructed to play specific, typical errors. (12 minutes)

Criterion Description:

Comprehensive exams are evaluated as Pass/Fail, based on the students' ability to successfully complete each element. Exams may be repeated if necessary. The School of Music considers a pass rate of 80% for first-time examinees to be successful.

Findings Description:

Of the 44 students attempting the final examinations, 33 (75%) passed and graduated in July 2016. One month later, 8 additional students passed the examinations and graduated in August 2016, bringing the pass rate to 93%. The remaining three students are enrolled for the 2017 session and will retake the examinations in July 2017.

RELATED ITEM LEVEL 3

Action for Advanced Skills in Band Conducting and Pedagogy

Action Description:

Two preliminary diagnostic and placement examinations will be administered prior to admission:

1. Exam #1 will cover all facets of embouchure, tone production, fingerings of woodwind and brass, percussion rudiments and techniques, as well as literature, rehearsal techniques, conducting and jazz.

2. Exam #2 will cover music theory

Results of this diagnostic placement examination will

- identify any needs for remedial work with individual students, and
- serve as the basis for specific Practical Applications projects as well as end-of-session examinations
- provide data to compare to results on the end-of-course written and aural exams.
