4. GENERAL PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

4.01 For purposes of tenure, the term "tenure unit" is defined as the faculty of a college which is not divided into smaller units, or of a department, or of an officially designated program or group of programs within a department, or of the Newton Gresham Library, who share in the obligations, rights, and protections of tenure within their discipline(s).
