

Online Course Redesign & Faculty Certification



To ensure we are meeting the needs of a growing online student population, the Provost for Sam Houston State University is requesting faculty complete the certification for online teaching.

In order to support this prerequisite for teaching online, SHSU Online developed a three-day Faculty Certification and Course Redesign program for online instructors. The program, predicated upon peer-reviewed research in online teaching competencies and best practices in course design, involves collaboration and communication between the online instructor, the program facilitator, and the SHSU Online course development team.

The Program

- Will be offered across multiple semesters at different times and via different mediums.
- Utilizes a guided course review and self-evaluation component

- Contains presentations on course design best practices and online pedagogies
- Involves collaboration and communication with Instructional Designers
- Provides a model course to begin the redesign process

- Faculty who have previously completed the Teaching Online with Blackboard
 Certification Series are encouraged to participate in future cohorts (coming this Fall).
- A waiver option is available for faculty whose online courses meet specific criteria.

Program Dates

SHSU Online offered 7 opportunities for enrollment during the Summer Pilot of the Course Redesign & Certification Program. All 7 cohorts were full after just 4 days of open enrollment. A final Summer cohort for newly hired faculty will take place in early August, 2018. More Online Course Redesign & Faculty Certification cohorts will be offered in the Fall.
