Official SHSU Directions

- 1. These guidelines specify directions for graduate students who are submitting a thesis or a dissertation in partial fulfillment of degree requirements.
- 2. The guidelines herein take precedence over those in the style manuals required by departments as well as earlier versions of the "Directions."
- 3. Students should consult their thesis/dissertation directors as to the required style manual.
- 4. Students should avoid using another thesis/dissertation as a model.

- 5. Because of the updating of style manuals and SHSU thesis/dissertation guidelines, what was accepted in the past may now be unacceptable.
- 6. The thesis/dissertation will be evaluated according to the current declared style manual and the current SHSU thesis guidelines.

Human and Animal Research Subjects (Institutional Review Board - IRB)

Research involving human or animal participants must be approved by the SHSU Committee for the Protection of Human Subjects prior to the commencement of the project.

Templates

Macro-enabled templates

Templates with Macros <u>do not</u> work well with Mac computers. These .docm Microsoft Word documents work best with PC computers.

• Template -- with macros This template works with Windows-based PCs, NOT Macs.

Right click on the link above, select Save Target As, and save the document where you can find it.

Next, open the document on your computer, click on the SHSU tab, then click on the Smiley face located on the right hand side at the top of the screen. This opens a series of dialogue boxes -- fill these boxes with the required information. Filling out the dialogue boxes will eliminate Error! messages in the document.

• Journal Style template -- with macros

This is a modified template that includes designation pages for journal articles.

Templates without Macros

These are regular .docx Microsoft Word documents that can be used by both PC and Mac users.

- Template -- without Macros This simplified template provides a basic format for creating a thesis or dissertation and can be used on either Macs or PCs. Download the file and save it to your computer.
- Journal Style template -- no macros This is a modified template that includes designation pages for journal articles.
